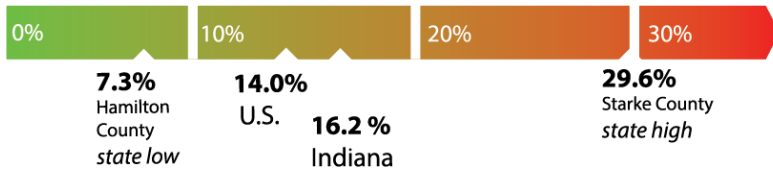


The state of tobacco control in Benton County

Tobacco and Health in Benton County

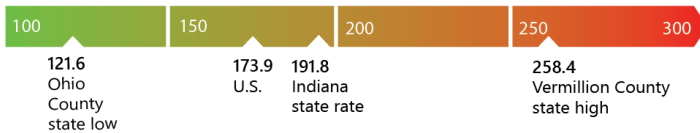
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.1%**



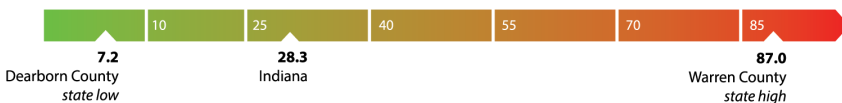
