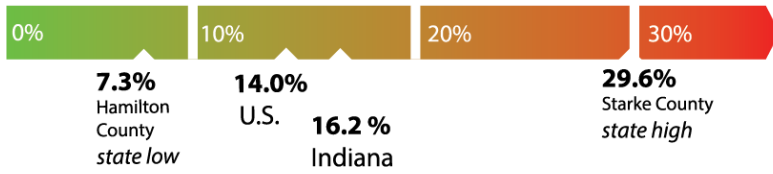


The state of tobacco control in Boone County

Tobacco and Health in Boone County

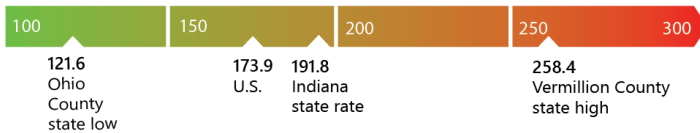
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **12.6%**



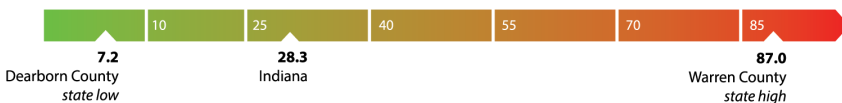
