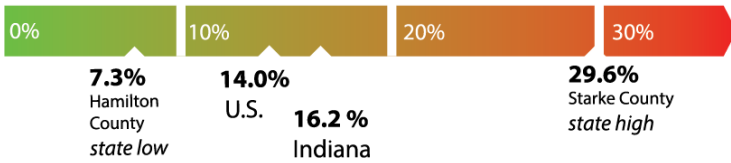

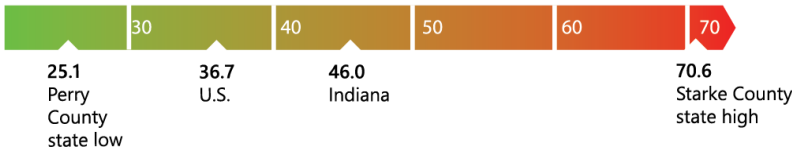

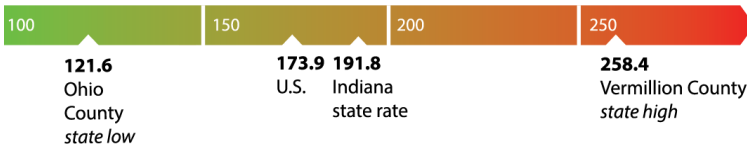
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.7%**



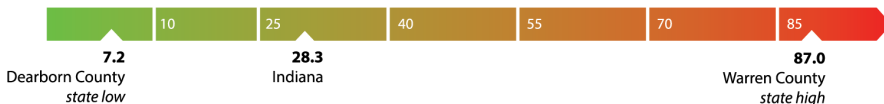
 **Lung cancer deaths** **51.6**
