

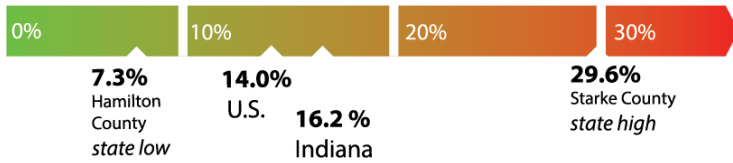

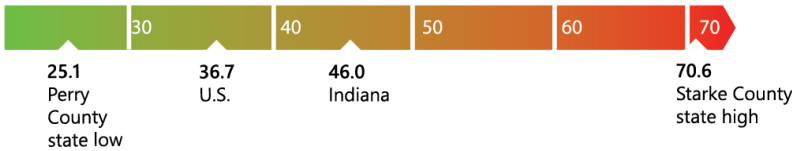

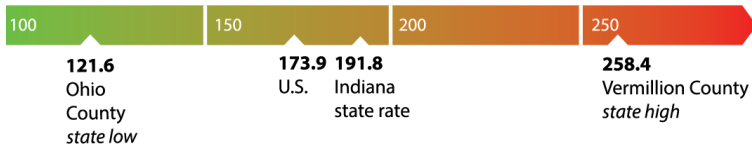
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **16.3%**



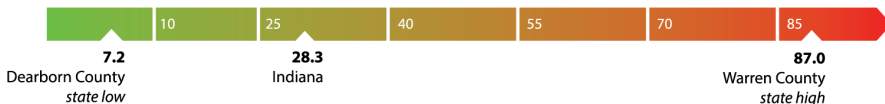
 **Lung cancer deaths** **45.2**
