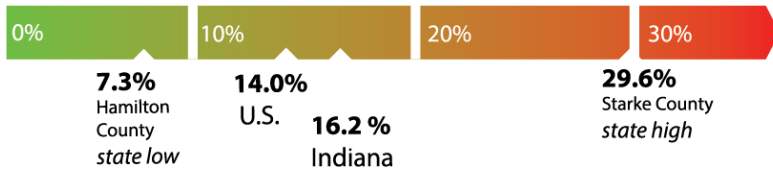


The state of tobacco control in Fulton County

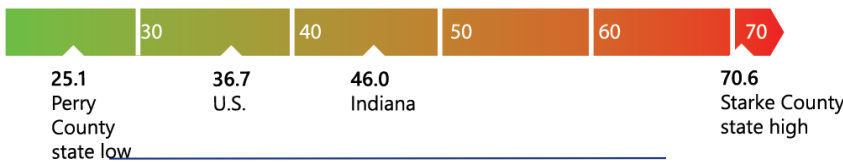
There is no tobacco control grant in Fulton County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Fulton County

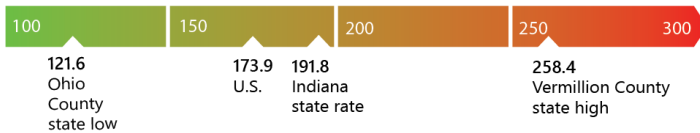
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.6%**



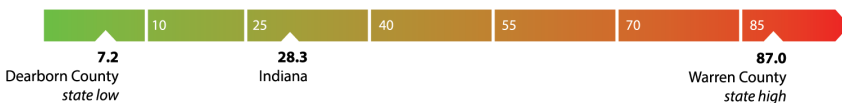
 **Lung cancer deaths** **50.7**
