

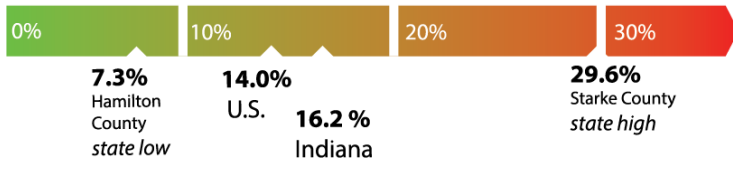

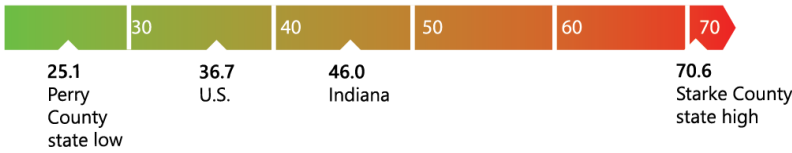

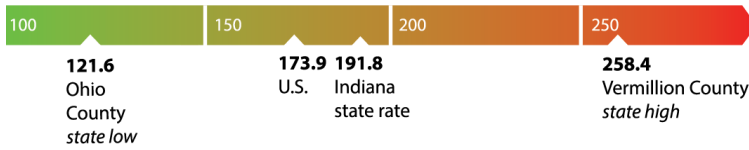
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **25.7%**



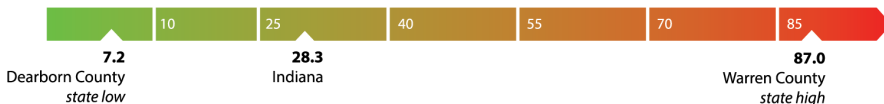
 **Lung cancer deaths** **58.3**
