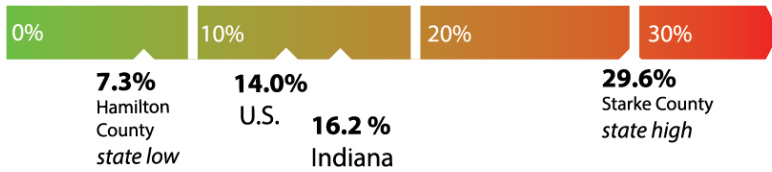

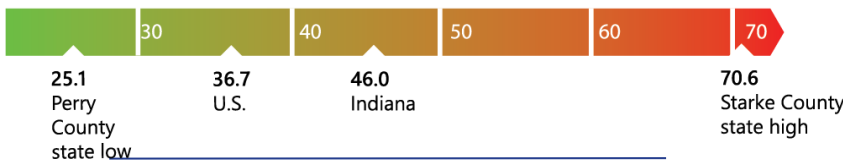

Tobacco and Health in Greene County

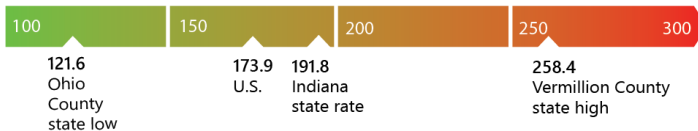
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.6%**



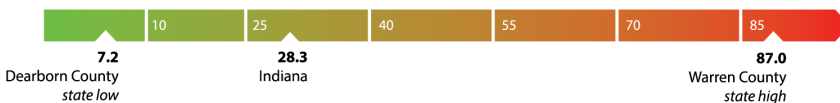
