

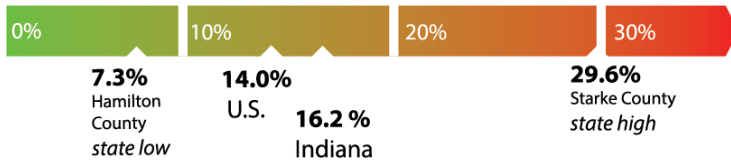

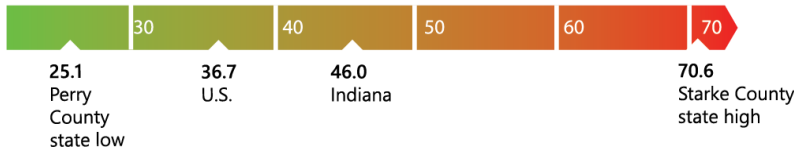

Tobacco and Health in Hancock County

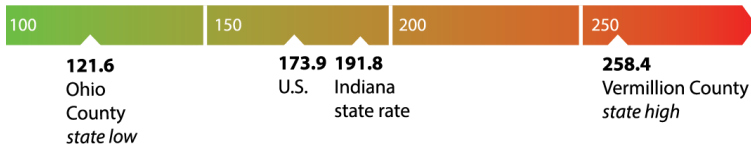
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **15.8%**



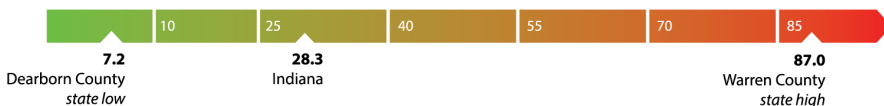
 **Lung cancer deaths** **44.5**
