

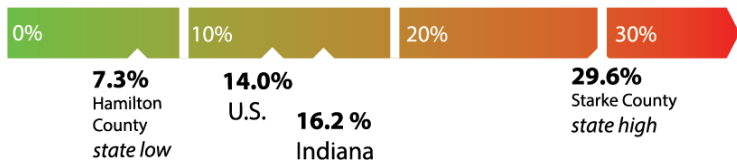

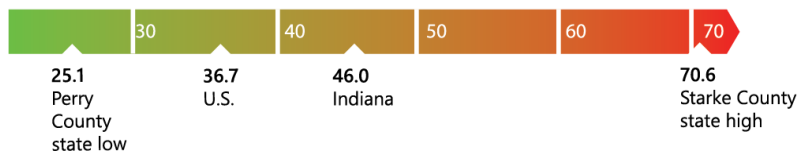

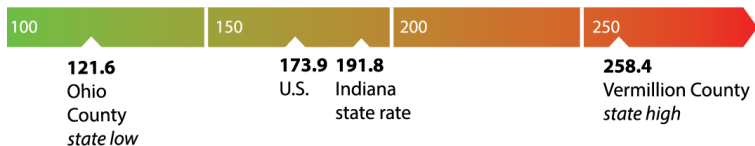
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **12.6%**



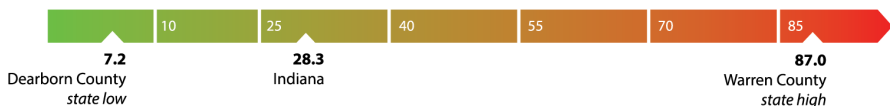
 **Lung cancer deaths** **37.4**
