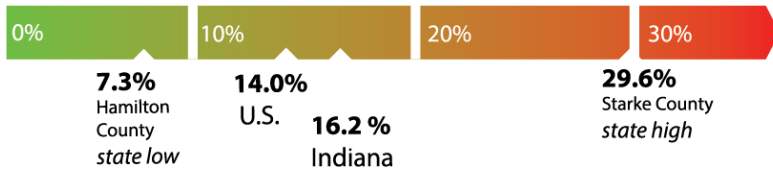


# The state of tobacco control in Montgomery County

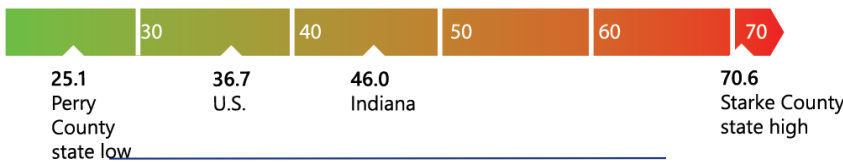
There is no tobacco control grant in Montgomery County for 2023-2025.

## Tobacco and Health in Montgomery County

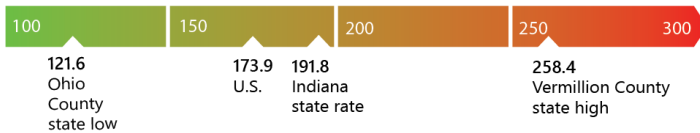
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.0%**



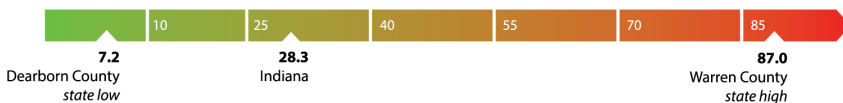
 **Lung cancer deaths** **43.5**
