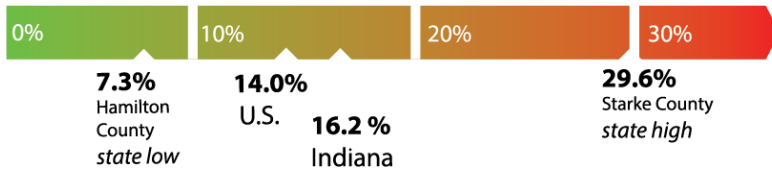

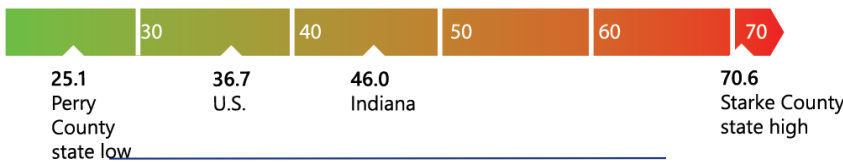
There is no tobacco control grant in Perry County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Perry County

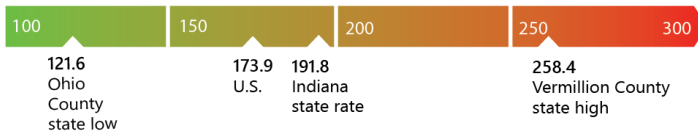
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **19.4%**



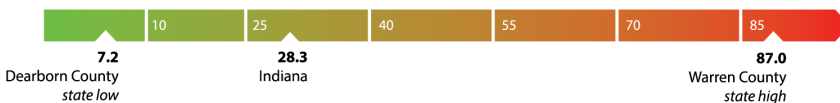
 **Lung cancer deaths** **25.1**
