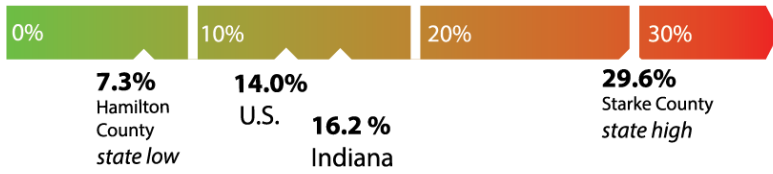


The state of tobacco control in Pulaski County

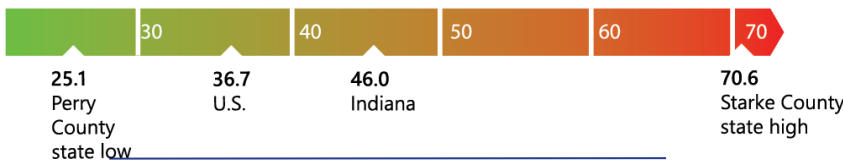
There is no tobacco control grant in Pulaski County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Pulaski County

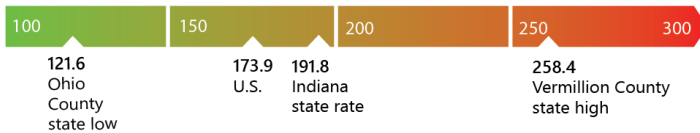
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.6%**



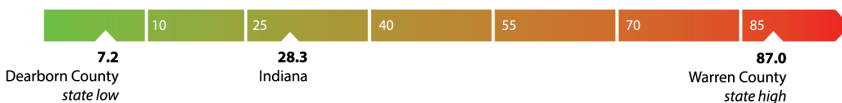
