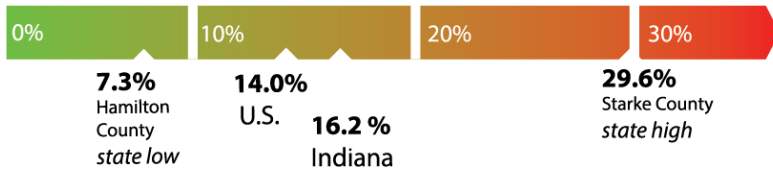


The state of tobacco control in Ripley County

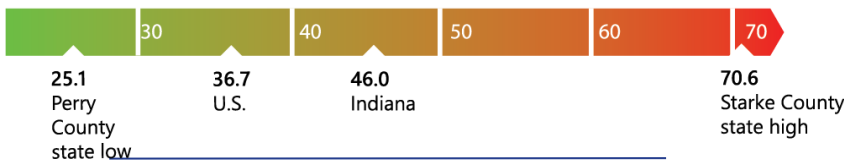
There is no tobacco control grant in Ripley County for 2023-2025.

Tobacco and Health in Ripley County

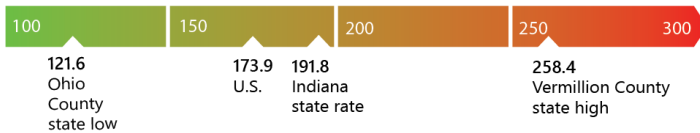
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **12.6%**



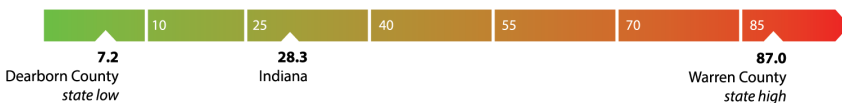
 **Lung cancer deaths** **36.6**
