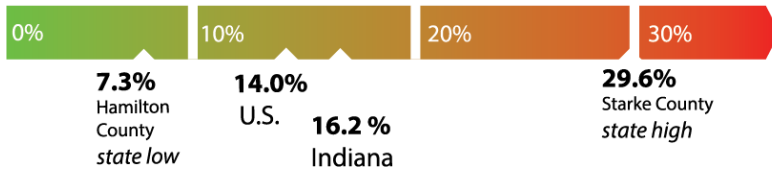


The state of tobacco control in Tippecanoe County

Tobacco and Health in Tippecanoe County

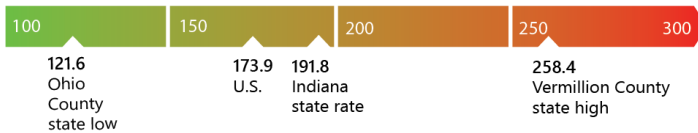
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **11.5%**



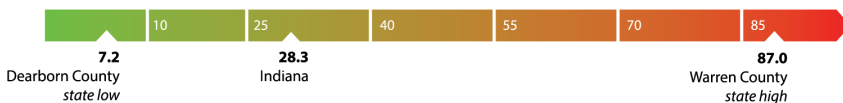
 **Lung cancer deaths** **38.8**
