## ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 1 - Luke Plano, driver of No. 6 THOM CRUISE, warned about keeping his feet on the stirrups.

Race 3 – Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 6 SWEET BOY BEN (John DeLong) for possible interference to unofficial fifth place finisher No. 4 AMERICAN FASHION (Marvin Luna) in the far turn going to 3/4s. Video showed that Mr. DeLong's horse struck Mr. Luna's outside wheel, however, Mr. Luna told the judges his tire did not go flat and did not affect his horse at all. Based on Mr. Luna's testimony and the fact that the tire was not flattened the judges determined no interference occurred and both horses were placed as finished.

Race 4 – Luke Plano, driver of No. 2 AIN'T SHE SPECIAL, fined \$300.00 for whipping with more than minimal wrist and elbow action in the stretch.

Race 5 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place winner No. 4 MCMATTERS (Trace Tetrick) for possible pylon violation in the first turn past the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>. Video confirmed that Mr. Tetrick was inside two pylons, however the horse was not lapped on, and the judges determined the horse did not gain an unfair advantage. No reason for placing. Driver Tetrick fined \$100.00 for a pylon violation.
