ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 4 - No. 6 SKY DANCE was first time Lasix. Announcements made via track announcer and TV scroll.

Race 8 – Jared Finn, driver of second place horse No. 10 RG'S SPARKLE, filed an objection against unofficial race winner No. 9 CHEERS TO THAT (Brad Ferguson) for jamming up and causing confusion. After speaking with Mr. Finn and reviewing video the judges disallowed the objection for a) when Finn pulled his horse past the quarter the rest of the field was comfortable and spaced nicely and b) any confusion that may have occurred was due to the horse sitting fourth on the rail running up on the horse sitting third AFTER Finn had cleared those horses and was first over.

Race 10 - No. 5 ROANANDOVER and No. 8 SWAN KING were announced as scratches and taken out of the betting pools by the mutuel department after paddock security reported that the horses missed check in time. After contacting trainer Doug Rideout he explained that the horses had been in the paddock since 8:00 AM which was confirmed by paddock judge Joe Thompson. The judges allowed the two horses to race for purse money only. Order of finish: 9-5-2-4-6 for wagering purposes bets were paid off on: 9-2-4-6
