

Welcome to the Indiana Quarter Horse Breed Development Program! You are about to be a part of one of the most lucrative regional breeding programs in the nation.

To help make the registration of your Indiana-bred easier, follow this checklist to ensure that you've followed through with all the requirements in order to run for our Breeder Incentives.

MARES

□ July 1 – Mare must enter Indiana and be registered with the Indiana Horse Racing Commission by July 1st of the year prior to foaling & remain in Indiana continuously until foaling.

- You can register <u>online</u> or print the <u>Mare Registration</u> and mail it in A separate application is needed for an <u>Embryo Transfer Mare</u>.
- □ Mare applications must be completed annually.

If your mare enters Indiana after July 1st of the year prior to foaling or Mare Registration is not completed by the deadline.

- □ Mare must remain in the state until foaling.
- □ Mare must be registered with the IHRC prior to foaling.
- □ Mare and Foal must remain in Indiana for 30 days after foaling.
- □ Mare must be bred back to a *registered* Indiana stallion after foaling.

* If you move your mare during the required residency timeframe, you must notify the IHRC by submitting a <u>Change of Residency</u> form either <u>online</u> or by printing the form and mailing it in *

FOALS

- □ Foals must be registered within the *first year* of the foaling date to avoid late fees
- You can register <u>online</u> or print the <u>Foal Registration</u> and mail it in A separate application is needed for an <u>Embryo Transfer Foal</u>.
- □ Late fee schedule is as follows:

12 months + 1 day to December 31st of yearling year: \$200 2 years old: \$400 3 years old & older: \$1,000



- November 1 Stallion must be registered by November 1st of the year prior to breeding season. Stallions must remain in Indiana for the entire breeding season (February 1 through July 1).
- □ Stallion must be registered before covering any mares.
- □ You can register <u>online</u> or print the <u>Stallion Registration</u> and mail it in:
- □ An application must be filed every year the stallion breeds in the state of Indiana.

A late fee of \$100 will be assessed for late registration of any returning stallion.

The late fee (\$100) is waived for new stallions standing their first season in Indiana. New stallions arriving late cannot have covered any mares in another state during the same year.

* If you move your stallion during the required residency timeframe, you must notify the IHRC by submitting a <u>Change of Residency Form</u> either <u>online</u> or by printing the form and mailing it in*
