Our office received the NPDES Notice of Intent (NOI) for the Flint Hill Mine on March 23, 2024 that was submitted by David McLimore on your behalf. We are pleased to inform you that the submittal is sufficient to comply with the NOI requirements of 327 IAC 15-7 and that your facility's permit coverage will be renewed.

We have reviewed your request and have determined that the activities associated with it will not violate the antidegradation rules as set forth in 327 IAC 2-1.3. Our office has further determined that the request will not affect this facility's eligibility for coverage under the general permit rules outlined in 327 IAC 15-1 through 15-4 and 327 IAC 15-7, Facilities Engaged in the Mining of Coal, Coal Processing, and Reclamation Activities. Therefore, your petition to obtain modified permit coverage as is described in your NOI has been approved in accordance with Indiana rules promulgated under 327 IAC15-7 and 327 IAC 2-1.3. Coverage for the facility will include all outfalls listed on the first table of Attachment 1 to this correspondence.

The NPDES general permit identification number assigned to this facility is referenced above. Current permit coverage expires on May 31, 2024, so renewed coverage will begin June 1, 2024. You will be required to follow all terms and conditions of 327 IAC 15-7 until coverage under 327 IAC 15-7 expires on May 31, 2029. In order to receive authorization to discharge beyond the date of expiration, the permittee shall submit such a renewal NOI to IDEM no later than ninety (90) days prior to the date of expiration.

Please note that IDEM is required to serve notice of its decision to accept your facility's renewal of coverage under the general permit in accordance with the requirements of 327 IAC 5-3-14. It should also be noted that any appeal must be filed under procedures outlined in IC 13-15-6, IC 4-21.5, and the enclosed Public Notice. The appeal must be initiated by filing a petition for administrative review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) within fifteen (15) days of the emailing of an electronic copy of this letter or within eighteen (18) days of the mailing of this letter. ## RENEWAL of COVERAGE under 327 IAC 15-7

**SUN ENERGY GROUP, LLC – FLINT HILL MINE,** Permit Coverage No. ING040292. The project location is 18879 North CR 500 E, Dale, IN (SPENCER COUNTY). The permittee has requested renewal of their NPDES general permit coverage under 327 IAC 15-7, the general NPDES permit-by-rule for Facilities Engaged in the Mining of Coal, Coal Processing, and Reclamation Activities. There are five active outfalls at this mine, all of which discharge into unnamed tributaries of Little Pigeon Creek. The GPS coordinates for Outfalls 006 and 007 are being updated to reflect the as-built locations. The effective date of permit coverage renewal is June 1, 2024. ## **Notice of Right to Administrative Review**

If you wish to challenge this permit, you must file a Petition for Administrative Review with the Office of Environmental Adjudication (OEA) and serve a copy of the petition upon IDEM. The requirements for filing a Petition for Administrative Review are found in IC 4-21.5-3-7, IC 13-15-6-1 and 315 IAC 1-3-2. A summary of the requirements of these laws is provided below.

The petition must contain the following information:

- 1. The name, address and telephone number of each petitioner.
- 2. A description of each petitioner's interest in the permit.
- 3. A statement of facts demonstrating that each petitioner is:
  - a. a person to whom the order is directed;
  - b. aggrieved or adversely affected by the permit; or
  - c. entitled to administrative review under any law.
- 4. The reasons for the request for administrative review.
- 5. The particular legal issues proposed for review.
- 6. The alleged environmental concerns or technical deficiencies of the permit.
- 7. The permit terms and conditions that the petitioner believes would be appropriate and would comply with the law.
- 8. The identity of any persons represented by the petitioner.
- 9. The identity of the person against whom administrative review is sought.
- 10. A copy of the permit that is the basis of the petition.
- 11. A statement identifying petitioner's attorney or other representative, if any.

Failure to meet the requirements of the law with respect to a Petition for Administrative Review may result in a waiver of your right to seek administrative review of the permit. Examples are:

- 1. Failure to file a Petition by the applicable deadline;
- 2. Failure to serve a copy of the Petition upon IDEM when it is filed; or
- 3. Failure to include the information required by law.

If you seek to have a permit stayed during the administrative review, you may need to file a Petition for a Stay of Effectiveness. The specific requirements for such a Petition can be found in 315 IAC 1-3-2 and 315 IAC 1-3-2.1.

Pursuant to IC 4-21.5-3-17, OEA will provide all parties with notice of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays, or orders disposing of the review of this action. If you are entitled to notice under IC 4-21.5-3-5(b) and would like to obtain notices of any pre-hearing conferences, preliminary hearings, hearings, stays, or orders disposing of the review of this action without intervening in the proceeding you must submit a written request to OEA at the address above.

This publication must be in the newspaper for a minimum of one day and must include the following language: (your facility name, address, address of the location of the discharging facility, and the streams receiving the discharge(s)) "is submitting a Notice of Intent letter to notify the Indiana Department of Environmental Management of our intent to comply with the requirement under 327 IAC 15-7 to discharge wastewater associated with the mining of coal, coal processing and /or reclamation activities. Any person aggrieved by this action may appeal in writing to the Environmental Law Judge of the Office of Environmental Adjudication for an adjudicatory hearing on the question of whether this facility should operate under this NPDES general permit rule. An appeal must be postmarked no later than fifteen (15) days from the date of this public notice. Such a written request for an adjudicatory hearing must:

- (A) state the name and address of the person making the request;
- (B) identify the interest of the person making the request;
- (C) identify any persons represented by the person making the request;
- (D) state with particularity the reasons for the request;
- (E) state with particularity the issues proposed for consideration at the hearing; and
- (F) state with particularity the reasons why the NPDES general permit rule should not be available to the discharger identified in this notice.



LOS ANGELES — The Godzilla-King Kong combo stomped on expectations as "Godzilla x Kong: The New Empire" roared to an \$80 million opening on 3,861 North American screens, according to Sunday studio estimates.

The monster merger from Warner Bros. and Legendary Pictures starring Rebecca Hall and Brian Tyree Henry brought the second-highest opening in what has been a robust year, falling just short of the the \$81.5 million debut of "Dune: Part 2."

Projections had put the opening weekend of "Godzilla x Kong: The New Empire," which sees the monsters teaming up instead of squaring up, at closer to \$50 million.

"It's a cinematic event, and we're seeing these iconic characters doing things we've never seen them do before," said Mary Parent, chairman of worldwide production for Legendary. "There's big swaths of the film that don't have any dialogue, where we put you with the characters, it's a very mythic experience."
