Transfer of Ownership

Pursuant to 327 IAC 5-2-6(c), the parties have notified the Indiana Department of Environmental Management (IDEM) of their intention to transfer NPDES Permit No. IN0064933 from Brampton Brick, Inc., the "current permittee" and previous owner of the facility, to BrickCraft, Inc., the "transferee" and future owner of the facility, effective as of September 13, 2024.
