Reduced nearly 75 million pounds of air emissions




This included over 48 million pounds of VOC reductions and nearly 14 million pounds of GHG reductions.





Conserved over 204.7 billion kilowatt-hours of electricity







Reduced over 516 thousand pounds of hazardous waste





Eliminated almost 225 million pounds of solid waste out of their processes







Data for these total emission and waste reductions came from the **Annual Partners Recertification** (APR) reports submitted from members in 2014 through 2023 covering ten year's worth of data.






