PROCLAMATION

Executive Order

TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY COME, GREETINGS:

- WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management seeks to protect Hoosiers and the environment; and
- WHEREAS, the Indiana Department of Environmental Management continually strives to improve Indiana's ecosystem for Hoosier citizens and visitors; and
- WHEREAS, November 15th recognizes the twenty-sixth America Recycles Day, a nationally recognized day for businesses, government agencies and individuals to consider the importance of recycling and to commit to reducing waste, making recycling an everyday habit, and buying recycled products; and
- WHEREAS, more than half of Indiana's waste goes to landfills or incinerators instead of being recycled. America Recycles Day, and every day, is an opportunity for Indiana residents to help reduce that number; and
- WHEREAS, IDEM educates and encourages Hoosiers to continue finding new ways to reduce, reuse and recycle. This America Recycles Day, Hoosiers are urged to make a difference for the environment and incorporate more recycling into their daily routines;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Eric J. Holcomb, Governor of the State of Indiana, do hereby proclaim November 15, 2024 as

AMERICA RECYCLES DAY
