III. Adoption of Past Minutes

Dr. Rebecca Holwerda, IDOA Commissioner, entertained a motion to adopt the minutes from the February Q1 Meeting,

- 3. Willing to travel for an in-person presentation at the Governor's Commission on Supplier Diversity Meeting.

V. Deputy Commissioner of Procurement's Report

Erin Kellam, Deputy Commissioner of Procurement, gave a prime spend report:

VI. State Educational Institution (SEI) Reports

Each SEI gave a brief overview of their overall goals and utilization percentages for the quarter from January 1, 2024 to March 31, 2024. The SEIs that presented their reports were:

- Indiana State University: MBE 3.99%, WBE 14.80%, IVOSB 0.04%
- Purdue University: MBE 3.61%, WBE 2.79%, IVOSB 0.68%
- Ivy Tech Community College: MBE 8.39%, WBE 8.08%, IVOSB 0.62%
- University of Southern Indiana: MBE 8.79%, WBE 24.27%, IVOSB 0.39%
- Vincennes University: MBE 2.88%, WBE 21.43%, IVOSB 2.03%
- Ball State University: MBE 1.32%, WBE 5.07%, IVOSB 2.02%
- Indiana University: MBE 4.44%, WBE 9.05%, IVOSB 4.00%

VII. INDOT DBE Program Update

Elizabeth Kiefner-Crawford, Director of the Indiana Department of Transportation, Equity Initiative Services Division gave the quarterly program update:

- DBE Certification Data (Through 5/29/24)
 - Total Number of INDOT Certified DBE's: 785
 - Expedited certification process with the City of Indianapolis is now active
 - New DBE applicants in 2024: 53
 - Total applications processed (New and Declaration of Eligibility): 304
- DBE Rule Updates
 - USDOT issued an overhaul of the DBE rules on April 9, 2024.
 - Effective Date is May 9, 2024.
 - INDOT is currently working through system changes to implement the new DBE rules.
 - Details and USDOT related training webinars can be found here.
- Workforce and Education
 - BY Roads hosting a second class in Evansville in August 2024. Register here.
 - Courses for Better Your Future will begin at the Madison Women's Prison in July 2024.
 Thank you to our partners at HIRE, ICRF and IDOC for their continued support.
 - In the high school space, we have three separate courses for students in junior year, senior year and recent high school graduates in two (2) INDOT districts.
- Uniform Report
 - Reminder: INDOT's current three-year DBE goal is 10.2%.
 - INDOT's current DBE goal attainment is 12.1%.
 - INDOT will be launching its disparity study later this year for a new three-year goal which will begin August 1, 2025.

VIII. Deputy Commissioner's Report

Kesha Rich, Deputy Commissioner, gave a general overview of the 1st quarter 2024. The report included:

- Certification Updates
 - Average days to process the MBE/WBE/IVOSB certification are stably below the ninety (90) day requirement.
 - Continue to send out certification expiration reminders.
 - Certification team is working with SEI's and other partner organizations on DSD MBE/WBE/IVOSB certification requirements and processes.
- Compliance Updates
 - Regular monthly audits, tracking good faith efforts.
 - IDOA DSD is the final approval authority on requests to change the MBE/WBE and IVOSB subcontract participation plan.
 - The DSD Compliance team is working with Procurement and other partner organizations to raise awareness about DSD M/WBE and IVOSB program requirements.
