

Amendment # 2

This is an Amendment to the Quantity Purchase Agreement **#9605, 3 Ring Vinyl Binders**, entered into by and between IDOA on behalf of All State Agencies (hereinafter referred to as "State") and Child-Adult Resource Services (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor") dated 07/09/2005. In consideration of the mutual undertakings and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties agree to amend the existing contract as follows:

To delete the item offering of "O" rings with overlays. "D" rings with overlays will still be available on QPA 9605.

All other matters previously agreed to and set forth in the original agreement and not affected by this Amendment shall remain in full force and effect.
