PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 et seq. and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18, hereby gives notice to William Warren Cady ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for a nonresident independent adjuster license with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on November 20, 2023.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-28-17 and Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18.
- 3. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) due

to Applicant's October 2, 1989, felony convictions for Embezzlement and Forgery, in the

state of Nevada.

4. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6) provides, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to

issue an insurance adjuster's license for having been convicted of a felony.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(c) provides that the applicant or licensee may, not more than

thirty (30) days after receiving the Commissioner's notice of refusal, make written demand

upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the reasonableness of the refusal.

6. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you

choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions.

Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the

State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an

administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information

from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED

pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-28-18(b)(6), due to Applicant's two felony convictions. Applicant

may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
