ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF NONRENEWAL OF LICENSE

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Amanda Lynn Williams ("Respondent") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Respondent is a licensed resident producer holding license number 3098877 issued August 27, 2015.
- 2. Respondent's license expires July 31, 2024.
- 3. On July 17, 2023, Respondent attended an initial hearing on three (3) counts of Child Seduction by a Guardian, adoptive parent, adoptive grandparent, custodian, or stepparent, a Level 5 Felony, in the Hamilton County Superior Court 5 in Cause No.: 29D05-2307-F5-004825.

- 4. On March 1, 2024, Respondent reported to the Department, via an authorized submitter, Respondent's pending criminal charges via the National Insurance Producer Registry (NIPR) Attachment Warehouse.
- 5. Respondent failed to notify the Department of Respondent's criminal prosecution within thirty (30) days of the initial hearing in the Hamilton County Superior Court 5.
- 6. On July 24, 2024, Respondent was convicted in the Hamilton Superior Count 5 of two (2) counts of Child Seduction, each a Level 5 Felony, under Cause No.: 29D05-2307-F5-004825.
- 7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(2)(A) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer license for violating an insurance law.
- 8. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-17(b) is an insurance law that states that not more than thirty (30) days after an initial pretrial hearing date, a producer shall report to the Commissioner any criminal prosecution of the producer initiated in any jurisdiction.
- 9. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), is an insurance law that states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to renew an insurance producer's license for having been convicted of a felony.
- 10. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that when the Commissioner refuses to renew a license, the Commissioner shall notify the Respondent, in writing, of the reasons for the nonrenewal. This Order serves as that notice.
- 11. The Commissioner further notifies Respondent that, pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d), Respondent may, within sixty-three (63) days of the mailing of this Order, make a written demand upon the Commissioner for a hearing to determine the

reasonableness of this action. Such a hearing shall be held within thirty (30) days from

the date of receipt of the Respondent's written demand.

12. This is considered an agency action. This action has been initiated by the aforementioned

authority. If you choose to appeal this agency action, the State of Indiana Office of

Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to

preside over this matter, and subsequently you will be contacted by the OALP with more

information to begin the administrative process.

WHEREFORE, based on the foregoing, the Commissioner of Insurance hereby notifies

Respondent that Respondent's license shall not be renewed due to Respondent's failure to

timely report criminal prosecution and for having been convicted of a felony.
