PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance ("Department"), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.* and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to Tracy Hall ("Applicant") of the following Administrative Order:

- 1. Applicant submitted an application for resident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance ("Commissioner") on June 13, 2024.
- 2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-6 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
- 3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
- 4. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not

fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to disclose a February 7, 2023, license denial by the Department and failure to disclose and provide complete documentation for the following criminal history:

- June 1, 2023, conviction for Possession of Marijuana, a Class B
 Misdemeanor, in Jackson County, Indiana under Cause Number 36D01-2212-CM-001417;
- b. February 5, 2024, pending criminal prosecution in Jennings County, Indiana, under Cause Number 40D01-2402-F6-000021 for:
 - i. OVWI with a Prior Conviction Within 7 Years, a Level6 Felony;
 - ii. Operating a Vehicle with an Alcohol ConcentrationEquivalent to .15 or More, a Class A Misdemeanor;
 - iii. OVWI Endangering a Person, a Class A Misdemeanor;
 - iv. Leaving the Scene of an Accident, a Class B

 Misdemeanor; and
 - v. Operating a Vehicle While Intoxicated, a Class C Misdemeanor.
- c. March 5, 2024, pending criminal prosecution for Possession of Marijuana, a Class A Misdemeanor, and Possession of Paraphernalia, a Class C Misdemeanor, in Jennings County, Indiana, under Cause Number 40D01-2403-CM-000085; and

d. April 25, 2024, conviction for Possession of Paraphernalia, a Class C Misdemeanor, in Jackson County, Indiana under Cause Number 36D01-2402-CM-000197;

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the Applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.

6. This is considered an administrative action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing. The State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby DENIED pursuant to Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) due to Applicant's failure to disclose and provide complete documentation regarding Applicant's criminal history and failure to disclose and provide documentation regarding Applicant's license denial. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
