PRELIMINARY ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
AND NOTICE OF LICENSE DENIAL

The Indiana Department of Insurance (“Department”), pursuant to the Indiana Administrative Orders and Procedures Act, Indiana Code § 4-21.5-1 *et seq.*, and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12, hereby gives notice to John David Jordan (“Applicant”) of the following Administrative Order:


1. Applicant submitted an application for nonresident producer licensure with the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Insurance (“Commissioner”) on July 16, 2024.
2. Before approving an application, the Commissioner must find that the applicant has met specific requirements under Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-8 and Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12.
3. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1) states, in part, the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for providing incorrect, misleading, incomplete, or materially untrue information in a license application.
4. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having been convicted of a felony.

5. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9) states, in part, that the Commissioner may refuse to issue an insurance producer license for having an insurance producer license, or its equivalent, denied, suspended, or revoked, in any other state, province, district, or territory.
6. Following a review of public records and the materials submitted by Applicant, the Commissioner, being fully advised, now hereby notifies Applicant that Applicant has not fully met the requirements of licensure, as stated by Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant failing to disclose a January 10, 2013, license denial by the Illinois Department of Insurance in an application and for having the same; having been convicted of a felony; and for failing to disclose the following felony convictions in an application:
 - a. October 3, 2002, conviction for two counts of Manufacture/Delivery Cannabis 10-30 Grams, both Class 4 Felonies, in the state of Illinois; and
 - b. October 3, 2003, conviction for two counts of Manufactures/Delivery Cannabis 30-500 Grams, both Class 3 Felonies, in the state of Illinois.
7. Indiana Code § 27-1-15.6-12(d) provides that the applicant may, not more than sixty-three (63) days after notice of denial of the Applicant's application is mailed, make written demand to the Commissioner for a hearing before the Commissioner to determine the reasonableness of the Commissioner's action.
8. This is considered an agency action by the Indiana Department of Insurance. If you choose to appeal this administrative action, please follow the aforementioned instructions. Subsequently, after the Department has received your written request for a hearing, the State of Indiana Office of Administrative Law Proceedings ("OALP") will assign an

administrative law judge to preside over this matter, and you will receive more information from OALP to begin the administrative process.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's request for licensure is hereby **DENIED** pursuant to Indiana Code §§ 27-1-15.6-12(b)(1), 27-1-15.6-12(b)(6), and 27-1-15.6-12(b)(9), due to Applicant's failure to disclose Applicant's four (4) felony convictions, license denial, and for having the same. Applicant may reapply for licensure not less than one (1) year from the date of this order.
