Nature of Business Relationship with Agency: Accelerate Indiana Municipalities (AIM) is a membership organization that represents municipal government in Indiana, with more than 460 cities and towns as members. AIM does not have any contractual relationship with the Office of Lieutenant Governor nor with any of the agencies within the purview of the Office of Lieutenant Governor.

State Why Acceptance is in the Public Interest: The director of intergovernmental affairs for the Office of Lieutenant Governor is responsible for establishing and maintaining relationships with local elected officials throughout Indiana, serving as a conduit between the lieutenant governor and local elected officials.
