

Milton O. Thompson (Chairman)

Mr. Thompson has a history of civic and community involvement such as Play Ball Indiana, Board Member of the Indianapolis Indians Baseball Club, Big Brothers and Big Sisters of Indiana, Central Indiana Community Foundation, Indianapolis Foundation, Indiana University School of Law Board of Visitors, Pan American Games General Counsel, Indiana Sports Corporation Vice President, Indianapolis Capital Improvement Board, Tourism Tomorrow Board of Visit Indy, Indianapolis Bond Bank, and Hoosier Lottery Commission. Statewide casino revenues fell by 3.22%, from \$2.36 billion to \$2.28 billion in FY 24. Casino wagering taxes for FY 24 were \$563.7 million, which was a 5.39% decrease over FY 23. Supplemental taxes for FY 24 totaled \$48.5 million, down 3.00% from FY 23. Year over year, wagering and supplemental taxes were down \$32.1 million and \$1.5 million, respectively.

Total state-wide casino win was \$2.40 billion, down 2.71% from \$2.47 billion the fiscal year before. The northern Indiana market saw a 5.60% decrease to \$1.02 billion. The racinos also experienced a 3.61% decrease to \$563.6 million. While the southern Indiana market realized a 1.82% increase to \$821.5 million.

Sports wagering taxes were up 8.61%, from \$39.6 million in FY 23 to \$43.0 million in FY 24. During FY 24, handle, or total amount wagered, equaled \$4.74 billion, an approximate increase of \$535 million. Online wagers accounted for 97% of all wagers made.

In January 2024, Harrah's Hoosier Park Racing & Casino unveiled its \$40 million expansion project. The project added 30,000 square feet to the casino floor, with 1,200 slot machines, 40 table games, a promotions and events center, and a high limits room. Additional food and beverage upgrades were also added with the expansion.

Churchill Downs opened that state's thirteenth casino, The Terre Haute Casino Resort, on April 5, 2024. The adjoining hotel opened on May 15, 2024. The project's total cost was approximately \$290 million and features 1,000 slot machines, 36 table games, 122 hotel rooms, a pool, and five restaurants and six bars.

The Commission also retained Spectrum Gaming Group to complete an update to its September 2022 Market and Policy Analysis: Prospective Internet Casino Gaming in Indiana. This update was posted to the Commission website on December 28, 2023. The update was done to provide legislators, stakeholders, and the public with the latest iGaming data.

FY 2024 TAX OVERVIEW


In FY 2024, gaming and sports wagering operations in Indiana generated **563,662,361** in wagering tax, **\$48,509,106** in supplemental wagering tax, and **\$43,001,837** in sports wagering tax for a total of **\$655,173,304**. As of June 30, 2024, **\$17,942,382,074** in Wagering, Supplemental Wagering, and Sports Wagering Tax had been reported since inception.





MBE/WBE UTILIZATION

Disparity Study

Statute requires the Commission to establish annual goals for the use of minority and women-owned enterprises (M/WBE). These goals must be derived from a statistical analysis of utilization study of casino contracting and purchases. Such an analysis, also called a disparity study, must be updated every five years.

In keeping with its statutory mandate, an update of the Commission's study was completed in November 2022. The Indiana University Public Policy Institute completed the study on our behalf, examining the contracting and purchasing practices of Indiana's casinos from 2017 through 2022. Based upon actual purchase data provided by the casinos and audited by Commission staff, the study period reviewed over \$1.7 billion in spending on goods and services.

In addition to a review of purchasing, also called utilization, a disparity study must also seek to establish capacity, which is a measure of all firms ready, willing, and able to provide goods and services to Indiana's riverboat casinos. The capacity estimate derived from the study is below.






Charity Gaming Licenses Issued




VEP Statistics

There were 6,372 active members from forty-two (42) different states in the Voluntary Exclusion Program (VEP) as of June 30, 2024. The graphs display the VEP participants, as categorized by age, gender, home state and length of exclusion. In FY2024, forty-two (42) forfeitures were approved by the Commission and resulted in approximately \$60,503 in forfeitures.







Member State



Member Exclusion Length




Member Age




ISRP Statistics

Pursuant to Indiana Code 4-38, the Internet Self-Restriction Program (ISRP) was implemented on September 1, 2019. ISRP only applies to mobile sports wagering. Mobile sports wagering is defined as sports wagering conducted through computers or mobile or interactive devices and accepted in the state of Indiana through an online sports wagering system approved by the IGC. To date, three hundred twenty-three (323) individuals have signed up for ISRP; with thirty-nine (39) individuals removing themself bringing the active total enrollments to two hundred eighty-four (284). The graphs below display the program participants, as categorized by age, gender, home state and length of exclusion.


Member Gender




Member State

Gaming Integrity Division

Gaming Integrity Division

The Gaming Integrity Division conducts specialized investigations, with particular emphasis on financial matters. The division works closely with casino internal audit, compliance, and finance departments to ensure casinos are employing best practices in maximizing the utilization of data to identify criminal activity. The data utilized includes suspicious activity reports, currency transaction reports, and multiple transaction logs. The Division has worked with both federal agencies and local prosecutors and law enforcement agencies in successful prosecutions involving money laundering and other criminal activity. Manny Becker the Investigator assigned to the Gaming Integrity Division received the Inspector General's 2024 Award for Excellence. A recent GID Case was cited in the 2024 US Treasury AML Risk Assessment. This Case resulted in a \$3.2 million narcotics trafficking, and money laundering organization being brought to justice. Emphasis on Casino Risk Assessments has resulted in substantial improvement in the ratio of cases to suspicious activity reports.
