

ORDER 2024-117

**AN ORDER OF THE INDIANA GAMING COMMISSION CONCERNING THE
PERMANENT SPORTS WAGERING VENDOR LICENSE OF HILLSIDE LLC D/B/A
BET365**

In accordance with and subject to Ind. Code ch. 4-38-6 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code, the Indiana Gaming Commission (“Commission”) has completed its background and financial investigation of Hillside LLC d/b/a Bet365 (“Bet365”) and has determined that Bet365 is suitable to receive a permanent sports wagering vendor license.

The issuance of the sports wagering vendor’s license is conditioned upon continued compliance with the following list of requirements:

- 1) Full compliance with all relevant orders, resolutions, and directives issued by the Commission.
- 2) Continued compliance with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code.
- 3) Submission of the required annual administrative fee described under Ind. Code § 4-38-6-6. The fee must be submitted on or before one (1) year after the date that the vendor begins performing services under a contract with a certificate holder in the conduct of sports wagering operations under Ind. Code art. 4-38 and on each annual anniversary date thereafter. Bet365 commenced sports wagering operations on January 31, 2024.

The Commission has determined that Bet365 is substantially compliant with Ind. Code art. 4-38 and Title 68 of the Indiana Administrative Code and is suitable to hold a sports wagering vendor license. In accordance with and subject to the conditions set forth herein, the Commission hereby **GRANTS** a sports wagering vendor license to Bet365 for a period from September 26, 2024, through January 30, 2026.

According to Ind. Code ch. 4-21.5-3, this Order is effective fifteen days after it is served.
