Re: Housing for Persons with Substance Use Disorder Request for Proposals

Responses

IHCDA, in conjunction with the Executive Director for Drug Prevention, Treatment and Enforcement and the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration's Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA), released a Request for Proposals (RFP) to create rental housing developments to house persons with substance use disorder using one of the following models: (1) permanent supportive housing utilizing housing first principles, (2) transitional housing with time limits on occupancy, or (3) Level II, Level III, or Level IV recovery housing residences. IHCDA has \$10,000,000 in National Opioid Settlement funding available to be used as capital funding for this initiative. Responses to the RFP were due by 5:00 PM Eastern Time on November 4, 2024.

The selection committee reviewing the RFP responses will consist of staff from IHCDA, the Office of the Governor, and DMHA.

IHCDA anticipates selecting four respondents with an announcement in December 2024. Each of the four selected respondents will be eligible to submit a full funding application in 2025 to receive up to \$2,500,000 in the form of a grant to develop rental units serving the target population. IHCDA intends to select the highest scoring respondent from the northern region, central region, and southern region and the fourth respondent will then be selected regardless of score or geographic region. Selection based on geographic distribution is contingent upon the quality and quantity of responses received.
