### Winter Contingency Plans:

#### Putnam County

- No formal winter plans in place. The hospital, airport, and Beyond Homeless Day Shelter are used as warming stations.
- Per the EMA Director there is a weather ordinance used as a declaration process of municipal and county roads.
- If the county goes “red” then the EMA teams will activate the shelters at various locations across the county.
- Will engage Red Cross in extreme weather conditions

#### Vigo County

- No formal contingency plans
- White Flag Program
  - Phone tree systems alerts Chairs for key partners to reach out to soup kitchens, transit station, veterans services, media, social media, Vigo County Library, police/sheriff departments and local churches
  - Pathways Drop In Center will open when temperature drops to zero or wind chill feels like zero.
    - Red Cross will assist with meals
    - Volunteers are trained and utilized to ensure adequate oversight
