The hours will be assigned by Chief of Police at 84 hours every two week pay period at an hourly pay rate.
- Work independently with limited direction to effectively meet deadlines and mitigate stressful situations.
- Comply with all Wolcott Police Department and Tri-County Schools policies, procedures, and guidelines.
- Comply with all applicable local, state, and federal regulations.

- Be a visible and engaged presence in assigned school(s).
- Interact with other law enforcement personnel.
- Stay current on student handbook information and changes in the law.
- Assist with traffic control.
- Investigate reports of criminal activity.
