Subgrantee Pre-Qualification Overview

The pre-qualification phase is designed to assess and confirm that all prospective subgrantees possess the technical expertise, experience, and financial stability required to deliver reliable, high-speed service effectively if awarded funding by the BEAD program.

- All prospective subgrantees must complete a pre-qualification application if they intend to participate in *any* round of BEAD subgrantee selection
- Participating in pre-qualification is *non-binding*. ISPs do not have to participate in any rounds of subgrantee selection after getting pre-qualified.

Pre-Qualification Portal

- The IBO is using the Ready.net portal for pre-qualification and all rounds of subgrantee selection
 - All materials must be submitted through this portal
- The pre-qualification portal will be accessible starting on **August 26 at 9 AM EST**

Registration

- All organizations must re-register for the Ready.net portal to participate in prequalification
 - You **will not** be able to use your previous registration to access the pre-qualification portal.
 - You **can** use the same email address when you re-register.
- Please have the primary contact for your organization register your organization
 - Multiple users can be added to the same organization and can work on all pre-qualification sections simultaneously
- Registration will be accessible from ConnectingIndiana.com starting August 26th at 9 AM EST
- Registrations will be approved within 1 business day. You will receive an email confirming access to the portal once approved.

Letter of Credit Certification

- During each round of subgrantee selection, prospective subgrantees are required to submit one of the following in an appropriate amount:
 - Letter of Credit from a bank
 - Letter of Credit from a credit union
 - Letter of commitment to issue a performance bond
- During pre-qualification, applicants will certify their understanding of these requirements and commit to uploading appropriate documentation during selection rounds.
 - Certification via checkbox.

Financial Statements

- Applicants must upload audited financial statements from the prior fiscal year.
- If an applicant does not have audited financial statements, they can upload unaudited financial statements and commit to submitting audited statements by the end of November.

Your documentation should be detailed and show that your organizations has key personnel with the necessary, relevant experience for executing on BEAD projects.

Instructions and links to resources, such as the NOFO or other NTIA Guidance, are available on all questions.

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Managerial Section

Resumes and Organization Charts

- Required to upload the following:
 - Resumes for all key management personnel in the organization. These resumes should be detailed and show necessary, relevant experience for completing BEAD projects.
 - Organizations chart(s) that shows the relationships between your organization and all parents, subsidiaries, or affiliates.

Readiness Narrative

- This narrative should be a single document that describes your organization's readiness to manage a broadband services network.
- This narrative can take many formats, but consider including information like:
 - Experience taking on projects of similar size and scope to what you may undertake in BEAD
 - Details about skills acquisition through merger or acquisition
 - Organizational policies that set you up for success with BEAD

Compliance with Laws

Certifications

1. Prospective subgrantees must certify, via checkbox, that they are capable of carrying out any BEAD deployment competently and in compliance with all applicable laws.
2. Prospective subgrantees must certify, via checkbox, they will comply with occupational safety and health requirements, including allowing workers to create work-led health and safety committees and ensuring management will meet with any health and safety committees periodically and upon reasonable request.

Legal Opinion

- This document should show your ability to carry out BEAD deployment competently and in compliance with all applicable laws.
- The document must include:
 - Details on any past violations or pending court proceedings that contradict your ability to comply with applicable laws.
 - A clear identification of the key management personnel who will be responsible for all aspects of legal compliance.
- This document can also provide details about organizational processes or procedures that will help ensure compliance.

Operational Capability

All prospective subgrantees must submit:

- The number of consecutive years your organization has provided internet service
- The number of consecutive years your organization has provided internet service in Indiana
- Current number of internet subscribers in Indiana

Applicants will then select the option that most closely aligns with their organization:

1. Has provided voice or broadband service for at least two consecutive years.
2. Subsidiary of a parent company that has provided voice or broadband service for at least two consecutive years.
3. Has only provided electronic transmission/distribution services previously.
4. New entrant to the market with less than 2 years providing voice or broadband service.

Operational Capability

Subsidiary of a parent company that has provided voice or broadband service for at least two consecutive years.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Same certification as above.• Upload a document detailing your parent company's number of years in service.
Has only provided electronic transmission/distribution services previously.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upload qualified operating or financial reports that have been filed with the relevant financial institution.
New entrant to the market with less than 2 years providing voice or broadband service	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Upload a document that provides evidence demonstrating that your newly formed entity has sufficient operational capabilities to perform BEAD deployment.

Ownership Section

All prospective subgrantees must provide a detailed disclosure of ownership and related companies. It must:

- Include a detailed ownership chart showcasing direct and indirect stakeholders
- Detail a list of associated FCC-regulated entities and clear explanations of relationships between the entities
- Be compliant with all requirements set forth in the Code of Federal Regulations Title 47 § 1.2112(a)(1)- (7)

Labor Laws and Protection

Past Compliance

- Upload one or several documents that include:
 - Information about the entities' compliance with federal labor and employment laws on broadband deployment projects in the last three years;
 - A certification from an Officer/Director-level employee (or equivalent) showing evidence consistent with past compliance with federal labor and employment laws, as well as all contractors and subcontractors;
 - Written confirmation disclosing any instances in which you or your contractors or subcontractors have been found to have violated laws such as the Occupational Safety and Health Act, the Fair Labor Standards Act, or any other applicable labor and employment laws for the preceding three years.

Future Compliance

- Upload one or several documents that detail your plans for continuing to be in compliance with federal labor and employment laws. This documentation should include:
 - How your organizations will ensure compliance across itself, contractors, and subcontractors;
 - Information on applicable wage scales and overtime payments practices for each class of employee expected to be involved in the physical construction of BEAD projects; and
 - How your organization will ensure the implementation of workplace safety committees that are authorized to raise health and safety concerns in connection with the delivery of deployment projects.

Other Public Funding

- In this section, prospective subgrantees must upload information about all their current broadband deployment projects using public funds, any projects that have been applied for, or projects the organization is planning to submit.
- Prospective subgrantees only need to include projects using public funds that are taking place in Indiana.
- **For each project, applicants must submit:**
 - The speed and latency of the broadband service to be provided
 - The geographic area to be covered
 - The number of unserved and underserved locations committed to serve
 - The amount of public funding to be used
 - The cost of service to the consumer
 - The matching commitment, if any, provided by you or your affiliates.

Be sure to include any projects funded by ARPA dollars, RDOF, CAF, NextLevel Connections, and the Indiana Connectivity Program.

Build America, Buy America

- Prospective subgrantees are required to certify, via checkbox, that they have read, understand, and agree to abide by all programmatic Build America, Buy America requirements.

Environmental Historic Preservation

- Prospective subgrantees are required to certify, via checkbox, that they have read, understand, and agree to abide by all programmatic Environmental Planning and Historic Preservation requirements.

Cybersecurity

Prospective subgrantees must attest, via checkbox, that they:

1. Have a cybersecurity risk management plan that is either operationalized or ready to be operationalized upon providing service;
2. The plan reflects the latest version of the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Framework for Improving Critical Infrastructure Cybersecurity (currently Version 1.1) and the standards and controls set forth in Executive Order 14028 and specifies the security and privacy controls being implemented;
3. The plan will be reevaluated and updated on a periodic basis and as events warrant; and
4. That the plan will be submitted to the Indiana Broadband Office prior to the allocation of funds. If the subgrantee makes any substantive changes to the plan, a new version will be submitted to the IBO within 30 days.

Supply Chain Risk Management

Prospective subgrantees must attest, via checkbox, that they:

1. Have a SCRM plan in place that is either: (a) operational, if the prospective subgrantee is already providing service at the time of the grant; or (b) ready to be operationalized, if the prospective subgrantee is not yet providing service at the time of grant award;
2. The plan is based upon the key practices discussed in the NIST publication NISTIR 8276, Key Practices in Cyber Supply Chain Risk Management: Observations from Industry and related SCRM guidance from NIST, including NIST 800-161, Cybersecurity Supply Chain Risk Management Practices for Systems and Organizations and specifies the supply chain risk management controls being implemented;
3. The plan will be reevaluated and updated on a periodic basis and as events warrant; and
4. The plan will be submitted to the Indiana Broadband Office prior to the allocation of funds. If the subgrantee makes any substantive changes to the plan, a new version will be submitted to the IBO within 30 days. The IBO must provide a subgrantee's plan to NTIA upon NTIA's request.

Low-Cost Plan Certification

- Prospective subgrantees are required to certify, via checkbox, that they will:
 1. Participate in the Affordable Connectivity Program or any successor program
 2. In the absence of either ACP or a successor program, adopt the low-cost plan outlined by Indiana in its Initial Proposal Volume 2

Revisions

- The IBO will review all applications on a rolling basis throughout and after the pre-qualification window
- During the review process, reviewers will make note of any revisions that are needed on each section of the application
- Prospective subgrantees will receive all revision notes at once. All members of the organization will be notified via email, and revision notes can be seen in the portal.
- **Subgrantees have 5 *calendar* days to revise their application once notified**
