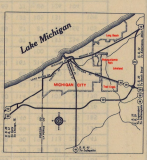


INDEX OF CITIES AND TOWNS (left column)

High Type: Concrete, Brick or High Bituminous.
Intermediate Type: Macul, Stabilized, Road Oil Mat.
Improved Type: Stone, Gravel or Dust Filled.
Low Type: Earth or newly graded section.
Under Construction: Make local inquiry.
Main connecting county roads.
