Public Information Meeting scheduled July 9th for US 31 Sidewalk Project from County Line Road to Thompson Road

The Indiana Department of Transportation (INDOT) will hold a public information meeting for the US 31 Pedestrian Project on **July 9, 2024**. The proposed project will install Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalks and curb ramps on both sides of US 31 from County Line Road to Thompson Road in Marion and Johnson Counties. The project will also include minor drainage improvements and a signal improvement at US 31 and Shelby Street.

The meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to interact with the project team and view project related materials, discuss the schedule, and provide ways for the public to stay informed and provide feedback.

The project is currently in the preliminary design process, which includes environmental investigations and preliminary design. This phase will last for approximately 6 months before the final design and right-of-way acquisition process begins. Construction is scheduled to start in the Summer of 2026. The Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) plan will involve temporary lane closures during construction.
