
What is the purpose of the proposed project?

The State Road 8 Access Management Project aims to reduce the frequency and severity of crashes, reduce congestion, and improve mobility for pedestrians along SR 8 in Auburn from 0.10 miles east of the I-69 interchange to 0.60 miles east of I-69.



What are the proposed roadway improvements?

- Add Raised Center Curb to improve safety between Touring Drive and Grandstaff Drive.
- Add Turn Lanes to Touring Drive and Grandstaff Drive intersections to increase capacity and reduce congestion.
- Add/Replace ADA compliant sidewalks along both sides of SR 8 to provide updated pedestrian facilities and improve connectivity.
- Consolidate driveway access for businesses to improve safety and mobility between Touring Drive and Grandstaff Drive.

Preferred Alternative



Reduce exposure to right angle collisions, often the most severe crashes, by restricting left turn movements.



Promote consistent speeds with less turbulence on SR 8.
