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Opportunity for Public Comment on Elkhart Municipal Water Works' Rate Case

WHAT: The Indiana Utility Regulatory Commission (Commission) will hold a field hearing in Elkhart to hear from the public on the rate case petition of Elkhart Municipal Water Works under Cause No. [46010](#).

WHEN: Tuesday, October 1, 2024 at 6 p.m. local time

Elkhart, IN 46516

WHY: Elkhart Municipal Water Works filed a petition before the Commission requesting approval to increase its rates and charges for water utility service.

HOW: During field hearings, ratepayers have the opportunity to speak directly to the Commission or submit written comments. Please note, though, that because this is a pending case, the Commissioners and Judge are not allowed to answer questions or engage in any discussion about the case.
