**Request:** Duke Energy Indiana, LLC (“Duke”) is seeking Commission re-approval of its Standard Contract Rider No. 58, Economic Development Rider (“EDR”). Duke’s EDR, which was last modified in Cause No. 44823, is currently available to customers through December 31, 2019. Duke is proposing to extend the availability of its EDR through December 31, 2024. Additionally, Duke proposes to extend the time a customer has to make the rider effective, from up to 18 months after the Service Agreement is approved to up to 36 months after the Service Agreement is approved. This change would provide more ease for a customer to receive a monthly bill reduction in months where they are at or near full load. All of the other terms of Duke’s EDR would remain the same.

**Customer Impact:** No customer rate impact is expected, as this filing only affects the terms of service.
