Request: New Lisbon is requesting approval of a new baseline intrastate access

tariff: New Lisbon Telephone Company, Inc. Intrastate Access Services Tariff I.U.R.C. No. 1. Effective July 3, 2024, NLTC will no longer concur in the Rochester Telephone Company Intrastate Access Services Tariff U.R.C. No.1. Instead, NLTC will concur in the TCA Interstate Access Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, subject to the intrastate exceptions shown in the referenced NLTC intrastate access tariff.

Retail Customer Impact: There is no impact on retail customers for NLTC's intrastate

switched access services. NLTC's intrastate special access services are not offered to the general public or to any residential customers.

Tariff Page(s) Affected: Tariff I.U.R.C. No. 1 ("Intrastate Access Services"), all tariff pages

and check sheets.

Staff Recommendations: Requirements in 170 IAC 1-6 and in IURC Cause Nos. 45733 &

44004 were met. This tariff became effective upon filing (i.e., on July 3, 2024), pursuant to Ind. Code 8-1-32.5-11(c). However, pursuant to IC 8-1-88.6 and as affirmed in Cause No. 45733, the Commission must still review the tariff to determine its reasonableness. After performing such a review, **Staff** believes the requested relief to be reasonable and **recommends approval of the tariff submitted as 30-Day Filing # 50761**. The approval date will be the date of the IURC conference at which the instant 30-day filing was approved through the Utility Articles process.
