**Request:** Duke Energy Indiana, LLC ("Duke") is seeking Commission

authorization to add Standard Contract Rider No. 55, Rate GSA - Green Source Advantage program for qualifying non-residential

customers.

Standard Contract Rider No. 55 will provide non-residential customers, with a minimum demand of 1,000 kW, an opportunity to bring new renewable resources online and receive the associated renewable energy certificates ("RECs") to help meet their sustainability goals. A service agreement between the customer, renewable supplier and Duke will be executed detailing the terms of service provided from a new renewable energy source. Duke will not be able to administer the program until February 2025 so the first

customer on Rate GSA will not be active until after that date.

**Customer Impact:** Eligible customers will be given the opportunity to obtain the RECs

to help meet sustainability goals.

**Request:** Frontier is requesting approval of an increase in monthly recurring

rates for intrastate special access – Voiceband and High Capacity Digital DS1 facilities. This is a stand-alone intrastate (IURC) access tariff filing that does not mirror, concur in, or adopt any interstate

(FCC) access tariff.

**Retail Customer Impact:** Frontier's intrastate special access services are not offered to the

general public or to any residential customers.

**Tariff Page(s) Affected:** Frontier North Inc., Tariff I.U.R.C. No. T-4 Facilities for Intrastate

Access

**Staff Recommendations:** Requirements in 170 IAC 1-6, and in IURC Cause Nos. 45733 &

44004, were met. Pursuant to IC 8-1-88.6 and as affirmed in Cause No. 45733, the Commission must review the tariff to determine its reasonableness. After performing such a review, <u>Staff</u> believes the requested relief to be reasonable and <u>recommends approval of the tariff submitted as 30-Day Filing # 50778</u>. The approval date will be the date of the IURC conference at which the instant 30-day filing

is approved through the Utility Articles process.
