Request: Duke Energy Indiana, LLC ("Duke") is seeking Commission

authorization to update its Standard Contract Rider No. 58 for qualifying non-residential customers eligible for a reduction in their monthly bill from an Economic Development credit with a demand of 20 MW or greater. Those customers may be required to maintain a higher monthly use threshold during the bill reduction period than the

250 hours required by customers under 20 MW.

**Customer Impact:** Schedule HLF and LLF customers with demand of 20 MW or more

and taking advantage of this Economic Development Rider's discounts may have those discounts limited by not maintaining a demand level above 250 per month as set by the Service Agreement

between Duke and the qualifying customer.
