The 70% or greater service connected Veteran is eligible for free nursing care at the Indiana Veterans' Home. This benefit at the Indiana State Veteran Home has no income limitation. (Reference 38 U.S.C. § 1745)

- Service connected rating is determined by the Regional VA Benefits office.
- The Veteran is entitled to keep all social security, pensions, and other income that would normally be used to offset their cost in a long term care facility.

All other Indiana honorably discharged veterans may obtain independent living, long term care, short term rehab care, and memory care if their application is approved using Medicaid, Medicare A, long term care insurance, and private insurance.

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Additional Information - Application Criteria

The Indiana Veterans' Home Admissions Committee reviews the application and medical information for each applicant in order to determine whether admission is approved. All applicants are admitted based on availability of space and the ability of the Indiana Veterans' Home to provide care, services and programs which meet the medical and mental health needs of the prospective resident. The Indiana Veterans' Home reserves the right to deny admission for any applicant.

The following veterans and spouses are eligible to apply:

- 1. Veterans who have received an Honorable Discharge from active duty in the armed forces and have resided in Indiana for at least one (1) year immediately preceding application (or were born in Indiana, or discharged from the armed forces to Indiana). Please note: residency requirements may be waived, on a case-by-case basis, at the discretion of the Indiana Veterans' Home.
- 2. The spouse or surviving spouse of an eligible veteran, if the spouse was married to the veteran for at least five years, and the marriage did not end in divorce.
- 3. The current spouse of a veteran who already resides at the Indiana Veterans' Home.
- 4. Veteran's Gold Star Parent (Parents any of whose children died while serving in the Armed Forces)

<u>Individuals requiring the following care/treatments will not be considered for admission:</u>

- 1. Requiring acute medical or psychiatric hospitalization.
- 2. Exhibiting physical behaviors which would pose an immediate threat to Indiana Veterans' Home residents, staff, volunteers, visitors or self.
- 3. Requiring in-patient substance abuse treatment.

Also, individuals would not be considered for admission if any of the below are found during the criminal background check per Indiana Code:

- 1. Applicants for admission, in the following categories, are not accepted:
 - a. Individuals determined to not meet the criteria of an eligible applicant.
 - b. Individuals who require medical and/or psychological services which are not available at the Indiana Veterans' Home or through community services.
 - c. Individuals who refuse to provide complete information requested in the application packet, refuse to permit access to medical records or submit to a medical examination, and/or refuse to authorize a background check.
 - d. Individuals who are found by completion of a background check to have criminal offense to include: Rape; Criminal Deviate Behavior; Murder; Voluntary Manslaughter, Involuntary Manslaughter; Child Molesting; Child Exploitation; Vicarious sexual gratification; Child solicitation; Child seduction and/or Incest if victim was less than eighteen (18) of age. Individuals who are found by completion of a background checks to have criminal offenses to include: Theft and felony battery, if occurred less than five (5) years prior to application.

Enclosed is the application for admission to the Indiana Veterans' Home. The professional and compassionate team at the Indiana Veterans' Home appreciates your interest in the only state veterans' home in Indiana.

Here are some important items to keep in mind as you complete your application:

- Please use the checklist for required documentation for applying to the Indiana Veterans' Home. The Admissions Department is available to complete the application for you either over the phone or in person (will need signature upon admission.)
- We accept Medicare A, Medicaid, private insurance and private payment. Special benefits are available for veterans with a service-connected disability rating of 70% or higher. When applicable, veteran benefits may also help pay for a part of your stay. If your insurance and benefits do not cover the full cost of your care and you are unable to pay from your own funds, we will help you apply for Medicaid after your admission to the Indiana Veterans' Home.
 - Enclosed is the financial checklist. The Indiana Veterans' Home will gladly provide you with an estimated rate cost upon receiving requested documentation.
- Veterans with a VA Service Connected Disability of 70% or greater or determined by the VA to meet the criteria for the Veterans' Administration VA Higher Per Diem Program participation, under 38 U.S.C. § 1745, qualify for free nursing care at the Indiana Veterans' Home.
- The current rate to reside at the Indiana Veterans' Home is \$415.14* per day. This is a comprehensive rate and includes nursing care, room, meals, housekeeping, laundry service, and recreation activities. We will work with you to determine your best options to pay for your stay with us.
- Effective April 1, 2016, the Indiana Veterans' Home Independent Living (Domiciliary) rate is \$138.00* per day. The Indiana Veterans' Home did research and decided to reduce the domiciliary rate to the State Veterans' Home domiciliary United States average daily rate.
- If you currently live at home and plan to move into nursing care, please contact your local Area Agency on Aging to set up a Pre-Admission Screening (PAS). The PAS must be completed before entering any nursing home in the state of Indiana. You can reach your Area Agency on Aging by calling (800) 986-3505. Please note: PAS is not required for applicants entering our independent living building.

PLEASE NOTE: The Financial checklist is enclosed in this packet. Copies requested are needed for IVH to determine an appropriate payer source and assist the new admission with applying for applicable benefits to offset any debt. IVH requires that any financial documents not provided prior to admission be sent to the IVH Business Office within ten (10) business days after admission. Failure to provide requested copies will result in a thirty (30) day involuntary discharge and the resident will be invoiced for the full daily rate.

Grievance Procedure / Concerns and Suggestions

Each resident has the right to voice concerns or complaints regarding care and services, any infringement upon resident rights, and to make suggestions for the improvement of services provided by the Indiana Veterans' Home at any time. If a resident has a problem or concern regarding his or her care, or if a family member is concerned about the care of a loved one living at the Indiana Veterans' Home, these concerns should be conveyed to management as soon as possible. The internal Concerns and Suggestion procedure is as follows:

- 1. Concerns and/or suggestions may be made verbally to the charge nurse, social services staff or other staff members at any time. Staff members are trained to address and provide immediate resolution when possible, to report this information to their supervisor and to the superintendent, when necessary, for resolution and feedback.
- 2. Concerns and/or suggestions may be presented to the Residents' Assembly, either in writing or in person, at regularly scheduled meetings. Such concerns and/or suggestions will be included in the minutes of the meeting and forwarded to the superintendent for response and to the chairperson of the Resident Council.
- 3. Resident Concern Forms are available from the corporal, unit nurses' station, social services department, administrative offices or the Pyle 1 switchboard. Residents and family members are encouraged to use these forms to submit written complaints or suggestions. Completed forms should be given to the unit charge nurse or social worker, placed in the Suggestion Box at the Pyle 1 switchboard or forwarded to the superintendent. If needed, social services staff are available to assist residents in completing these forms.

Staff members are available to receive resident comments and/or concerns during normal business hours. After hours, residents can contact the nursing supervisor on duty or the switchboard operator to request immediate assistance with an urgent concern. Complaints involving any form of abuse or significant care issues should be reported immediately to the superintendent, the director of nursing and the social services director.

Although it is recommended that residents report problems internally first, residents may also report a concern or voice a suggestion externally, at any time. If desired, residents may contact:

Long-Term Care Ombudsman

A long-term care ombudsman is a representative for residents. The responsibilities of the local ombudsman include the following:

- Investigate and seek to resolve complaints about nursing facility care that affect the health, welfare or quality of life of a nursing facility resident;
- Protect the rights of residents;
- Assist residents in asserting their rights;
- Work to insure quality care and treatment of residents;
- Answer questions and provide information about nursing facility care and related services; and,

• Educate residents, families, staff and community about nursing facility residents' rights.

Anyone can contact the ombudsman for assistance. Please note that the involved resident will be consulted, and he or she will normally determine the actions of the ombudsman. Volunteers who assist the ombudsman may also visit and assist residents on a regular basis.

Residents' Assembly

All residents are encouraged to participate in the Residents' Assembly. This organized resident group holds meetings each month, usually on the first Tuesday of the month, in the MacArthur Auditorium. All residents are encouraged to attend these meetings. Elected officers include chairperson, vice chairperson, secretary and vice secretary. Elections are held annually. Residents will receive assistance with transportation to assembly meetings if requested. Mini-assembly meetings are held on some nursing units, as needed or requested. When a resident is unable to attend a Residents' Assembly meeting, he or she should feel free to relay comments, suggestions or concerns to the Residents' Assembly through the assembly officers.

Voting: Government Elections

The Social Services and Recreation Departments make arrangements for residents to vote in all government elections. New residents are advised to register to vote as soon as possible after admission to report their new place of residence. Polls are provided on the grounds of the Indiana Veterans' Home at a location which is announced before each election. Residents who need to register to vote or wish to make arrangements for absentee balloting should contact their social worker or the Local Elections Board. The
