

# Indiana Center for the Book Announces the 2024 Indiana Early Literacy Firefly Award






In the book, a parade of animals tell us what they are called as babies. Hilarity ensures when the babies discover that some of them are referred to by the same name. For example, when they are babies, penguins, ostriches, and chickens are all called "chicks." The book is a hilarious rhyming romp that delights all ages. This is the tenth year of the Indiana Early Literacy Firefly Award. Votes were submitted from 45 Indiana counties and over 3,000 Indiana children ages 0-5 voted.

Author Meg Fleming sent in the following remarks:



When I heard the news that I Was Born a Baby won the Indiana Early Literacy Firefly Award I was thunderstruck. While all awards are truly an honor, this one is decidedly special because the votes came in from real kids! (Not goats, mind you. Although, I hope they'd approve.) This book was inspired by my youngest son who, when he was three, walked in the room and made the declaration, "I was born a baby!" Several years later, I was thinking up a clever way to teach kids all the baby animal names and I remembered his declaration. That's when I started to wonder what baby animals would think about their own baby names. The rest is history. I proudly share this award with the immensely talented illustrator, Brandon James Scott, whose irresistible illustrations are full of dry wit, humor and warmth. (Tipping my hat to Brandon!) Thank you again to everyone who was instrumental in sharing I Was Born A Baby with the kids in Indiana. I am honored and gobsmacked! Lastly, I'm pretty sure this book was born... a booklet? 

## Indiana Early Literacy Firefly Award Ballot: 2024




### Indiana children ages 0-5 can vote with a caregiver.

Every child in Indiana, aged 0-5, may vote one time for the Indiana Early Literacy Firefly Award. Children will need the help of a parent, a librarian, a teacher, or other caregiver adult to circle one of the titles. Ask the child to point to their favorite. Once their vote is circled, turn this ballot in to your local Public Library or voting location. Libraries will then email their totals to the Indiana Center for the Book. The last day to report votes is July 31, 2024.


