Library Development Office (LDO)

- The Library Development Office supports the improvement and development of library services to all Indiana citizens.
- Includes consultants in the areas of library finance, management, library standards and certification, resource sharing, statistics, grants, trustees, planning, evaluation and expansion.
- Administers statewide library services like INSPIRE.in.gov, InfoExpress, LSTA grants, E-Rate, Indiana Share and the Read-To-Me Program.

Professional Development Office (PDO)

- The Professional Development Office supports the advancement and development of library staff in all Indiana libraries for improved services to the citizens of Indiana.
- Regional coordinators – with expertise in library services – are available for every library in the state and can provide staff development on library-related topics.
- Administers the Indiana Library Leadership Academy and the Difference is You conference through the Indiana State Library Professional Development Committee.
