Three Libraries Receive Authors Award Grants

The hometown libraries of the three Indiana authors who were recently awarded the 2010 Eugene & Marilyn Glick Indiana Authors Award will each receive \$2,500 grants this month. The Award, a program of the Indianapolis-Marion County Public Library Foundation, and the subsequent grants seek to recognize the contributions of Indiana authors to the literary landscape in Indiana and across the nation. The Award recognition and the grants to the following libraries are funded by the generosity of The Glick Fund, a fund of the Central Indiana Community Foundation:

- National Author Winner Scott Russell Sanders has named the *Monroe County Public Library in Bloomington*.
- Regional Author Winner Ray Boomhower has named the *Mishawaka-Penn-Harris Public Library in Mishawaka*.

 Emerging Author Winner Gregory Schwipps named the Milan Branch of the Osgood Public Library in Milan.

Public nominations for the award were submitted from across the state earlier this year and eligibility included any published writer who was born in Indiana or has lived in Indiana for at least five years. An eight-member, statewide Award Panel selected the winners in the three categories, which were announced last month.
