

## **INFORMATION ON BURNING** 2010

It is against the law to burn trash, tires, manure/waste, batteries, rubber, treated wood and disposable diapers in the State of Indiana.

You are allowed to burn clean wood products, leaves and branches. However, nothing is to be burned after sunset and all fires must be attended at all times.

If you burn illegally, you can be reported to the Indiana Department of Environmental Management and be fined!

You can report any illegal burning and have a brochure sent to a violator by calling (800) 451-6027.
