



## Memorandum of Understanding between NWI No Child Hungry, Inc and Porter County Health Department

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) has been entered into by and between NWI No Child Hungry, Inc (NWINCH) and the Porter County Health Department (PCHD). It is intended to memorialize and document certain mutual understandings reached, and to facilitate joint collaboration in advancing the jointly held mission of promoting and protecting the health and wellbeing of the citizens of Porter County. To that end, the PCHD and NWINCH will proceed as follows:

- The PCHD will place orders for NWINCH through the Foodbank of Northwest Indiana that will be delivered to the Church of the Four Seasons located at 9100 E 109<sup>th</sup> Ave. Crown Point, IN 46307 for distribution to Porter County students through their Buddy Bags Program.
- 2. NWINCH will provide a confirmation of the items received along with a report of the number of items distributed monthly to the PCHD.
- 3. The PCHD will continue to look at the needs throughout the school year and work to help address those needs while balancing the needs of all Porter County schools and the funds that are available.
- 4. The term of this MOU shall be for a period of one year from the date of the last party's signature. Either party may terminate the provisions of the MOU, with or without cause, upon thirty day written notice to the other party.
