


## Powers Health



Based on the National Diabetes Statistics Report, we can reason that nearly 66,000 Porter County residents have prediabetes and are unaware of this reversible health state and the steps needed to take back their health. In efforts to increase community detection of prediabetes, the Porter County Health Department is partnering with Powers Health to help inform and protect the public from possible long-term complications.



As part of our initiative to detect prediabetes, a Certified Diabetic Educator from Powers Health will facilitate the program using an A1C analyzer to facilitate early, definitive diagnosis of prediabetes or diabetes. Because the analyzer provides results in a timely fashion, patients will be counseled and referred to additional support if necessary. The portable nature of the machine will enable outreach to populations who may lack regular access Identifying diabetes early can help prevent serious, sometimes irreversible complications.
