COVID-19 Cases Update

St. Joseph County- As of today, the county's total number of confirmed cases is at 606. We are also confirming one new death related to COVID-19 infection, bringing the County's total deaths to 20.

Beacon Health System will host a mobile testing site Wednesday, April 29 from 12 -3 p.m. at Mount Carmel Missionary Baptist Church (1620 S. Saint Joseph St., South Bend). Individuals must be experiencing symptoms (fever, cough, or shortness of breath). Testing is available on a first come, first served basis.

The St. Joseph County Department of Health urges the continuation of the following actions:

- Practice extreme physical distancing.
 - o Maintain at least 6ft between individuals.
 - o Wearing a mask does NOT eliminate the need for physical distancing.
- Practice frequent and proper hand hygiene & cough etiquette.
 - Wash hands often, for at least 20 seconds, with soap & water; coughing and sneezing into your sleeve.
- Stav home if ill.
- Adhere to the current Stay-at-Home order which has been extended to May 1, 2020.
